- Full tuition fees waivers from Walailak University: 187,500 THB/semester (for 3 years/6 semesters)
- Research grants: 100,000 THB as per university conditions
- Living allowance support (20,000 THB/semester)



Eligibility

- All nationalities
- University lecturers/personnel from government/private sectors
- Age ≤40
- GPA Master: ≥3.60 (4.00), and Bachelor ≥ 3.40 (4.00)
- English proficiency at least: TOEFL ITP ≥500; TOEFL CBT ≥173; TOEFL IBT ≥61; IELTS ≥5.5; WU-TEP ≥74; CEFR or British Council English Score B2 (expiration before 2 years; certificate must be submitted together with other documents)
- Candidates must have good physical and mental condition and must not be pregnant
- Research/Publication Track Record

Must publish at least 2 articles in Scopus Q1
(Percentile ≥ 85).

Type 1: Five Full Tuition Fees Waivers Scholarships offered for all nationalities:

- Full tuition fees waivers: 172,500 THB/semester for 4 semesters (for 2 years/4 semesters)
- Research grants: 50,000 THB as per university conditions
- No living allowance



Type 2: Five Full Tuition Fees Waivers Scholarships With Ext. Fund (External Funding from TIPP/TICA) offered for all nationalities:

- Full tuition fees waivers from Walailak University: 172,500 THB/semester (for 2 years/4 semesters)
- Research grants: 50,000 THB as per university conditions
- Living allowance from TICA/TIPP



Eligibility

- All nationalities/Intend to pursue PhD at WU
- Priority is given to candidates who are employed in the government sector or in a discipline related to the program, or who are working at a university.
- GPAX > 3.25 (4.00)
- English proficiency at least: TOEFL ITP ≥450; TOEFL CBT ≥153; TOEFL IBT ≥45; IELTS ≥5; WU-TEP ≥63; CEFR or British Council English Score B1 (expiration before 2 years; certificate must be submitted together with other documents)
- Candidates must have good physical and mental condition and must not be pregnant
- Research/Publication Track Record



Publication Requirement

Must publish at least 1 article in Scopus (Q2 or higher).



Duration 4 semesters/2 years.
